PROCLAMATION

Recognizing January 9th as Law Enforcement Appreciation Day

There are approximately 900,000 law enforcement officers servicing in communities across the United States, including 22 sworn members of the Township of Scott's Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the members of the law enforcement department of Scott play an essential role in safeguarding the rights and freedoms of the residents of the Township ; and

WHEREAS, some 60,000 assaults against law enforcement officers are reported each year, resulting in approximately 16,000 injuries; and

WHEREAS, since the first recorded death in 1792, more than 18,000 law enforcement officers in the United States have made the ultimate sacrifice and been killed in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, the names of these dedicated public servants are engraved on the walls of the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial, which was dedicated in 1991 in Washington, D.C; and

WHEREAS, Officers make the ultimate sacrifice every day, while on patrol.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, The Township of Scott proclaims January 9th as Law Enforcement Appreciation Day in the Township of Scott, and encourage our citizens to remember our police officers.
