# Scott Township - Garbage & Recycling Pick-Up

**1. REGULAR CURBSIDE COLLECTION:** Garbage and refuse should be placed at the curb the night before your scheduled pick-up.

## 2. GUIDELINES FOR COLLECTION:

- Garbage should be in properly secured containers or plastic bags.
- One large item including all furniture items, appliances, household goods and disassembled children's swing sets will be accepted at curbside per week.
- Carpet should be rolled and tied in lengths not to exceed 48 inches so that one man can lift.
- Empty paint cans and/or dried paint is acceptable. Paint can be dried by air drying or soaking up with newspaper or kitty litter. Lids should be left off.

## 3. EXCLUDED ITEMS:

- Building materials may be picked up for a fee by calling **Waste Management at 1-800-866-4460**
- Tires
- Automobile parts, including wheel rims.
- Trees and branches.
- Ashes from furnaces and fireplaces.
- Stones and dirt, liquid paint.

## 4. RECYCLING

Recyclables should be placed loose in a single container.

**SINGLE STREAM RECYCLE:** Residents do not have to separate the plastics—Type 1 through 7, metals, glass and papers.

## ACCEPTABLE ITEMS INCLUDE:

- Metal:** Metal food cans, aerosol cans (empty), aluminum foil and foil products (clean), beer and soft drink cans
- Plastic:** Plastic baby wipe containers, bleach, detergent, household cleaner bottles, yogurt cups, food containers, margarine tubs, shampoo bottles
- Glass:** Beverage bottles and food jars (clear, brown, amber and green)
- Paper:** Paperboard boxes (cereal, tissue, shoes etc.), white office paper, computer paper, magazines, newspapers, advertising inserts, junk mail (including envelopes), catalogs, phone books, paperback books, coupons and receipts, paper bags and shopping bags (handles removed), corrugated, **note: corrugated must be tied or bundled no longer than 14" x 14"**.

Recyclables will be picked up every other week on your regular garbage pick-up day. The municipality will be divided into two sections, **(A)** and **(B)**. Please refer to the street listing (visit [www.scott-twp.com](http://www.scott-twp.com)) to be sure when service will be provided and refer to the calendar below.

**5. HOLIDAY SERVICE:** If a holiday falls on Monday, pickup will be one day later, Tuesday. **Observed holidays for 2017 are:** New Years Day, Memorial Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas Day. If the holiday should fall on a weekend, your pickup day will not be affected.

## 6. APPLIANCES CONTAINING REFRIGERANT:

The contractor will collect such items as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, water coolers, etc.; however, the item must have a sticker certifying that refrigerant has been removed. If it does not have the sticker, it will not be picked up because it is unlawful for the contractor to dispose of these items containing refrigerant. To save refrigerant removal costs, it is suggested that residents have the company delivering the new appliance dispose of the old appliance.

## 7. QUESTIONS REGARDING REFUSE OR RECYCLING COLLECTION AND BILLING CALL:

Please look for your street name on either Schedule **A** or Schedule **B** for your recycling pickup date.

**Regular Curbside Collection:** Garbage and refuse should be placed at the curb after 6 p.m. on Sunday and before 6 a.m. on Monday for collection.

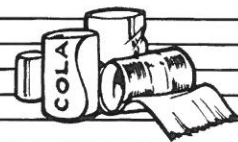
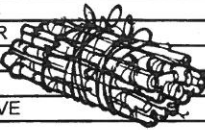

\*The township has discontinued the refundable cleaning fee of \$25 on the rentals of the outdoor shelters. However, if any picnic tables are removed from the shelter, or if the shelter is left dirty and/or damaged, the township reserves the right to collect from the resident/permit holder the total cost to clean/repair the shelter.

**Picnic tables are not to be removed from the shelters.**

**Locust Shelter:** Fri - Sun & Holidays: (3) section minimum for rental

**Community Room:** This room has (10) long tables which will seat (10), and (2) long food serving tables, there is a caterer's kitchen which has a stove, oven, and refrigerator. This room has A/C

**Lodge:** This room has (9) round tables, which will seat (8), there are also (2) long food serving tables. The kitchen has a stove, oven, refrigerator, and cooler. This room has A/C

**Outdoor Shelters:** All of the outdoor shelters have electricity.

Reservations for 2017 will be accepted starting Monday, November 7, 2016, in the Township Administrative Office at 8:00 a.m. 301 Lindsay Road, 2nd Floor. Business/organizations within the township wishing to reserve the park facilities must wait until January 3, 2017. Permits for park facilities cannot be issued unless full payment for rental is received at the time of application.

Permit holder must be at least 21 years old and a resident of Scott Township. A "resident" of Scott Township is an individual that lives/resides in the township.

**A \$50 refundable cleaning fee is included in the total cost for the rental of the Community Room and Lodge. The board approves all refunds, so please allow 4 to 6 weeks for your refund check to be mailed to you.**

**Request for refunds must be received within (30) days from the application date or the request will be denied. Refer to rule #3 & #4**

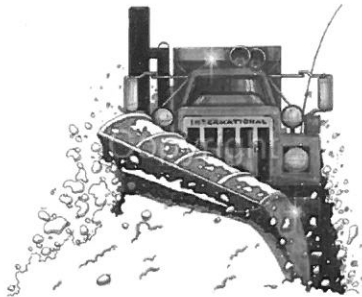

Our Public Works Department is already gearing up for the winter season. There are ways you can help them do a more efficient job and keep the roadways safe.

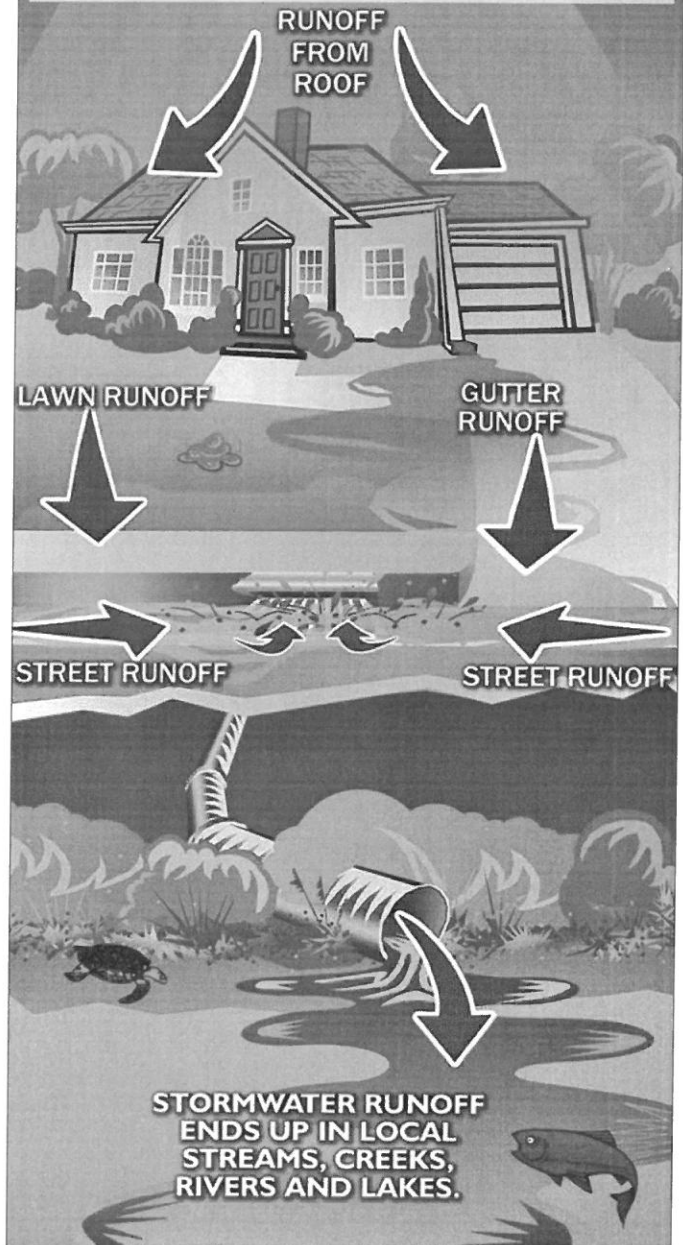


- \* Keep parked cars off the street during snowfalls. Snow removal crews need to be able to remove snow from the entire roadway.

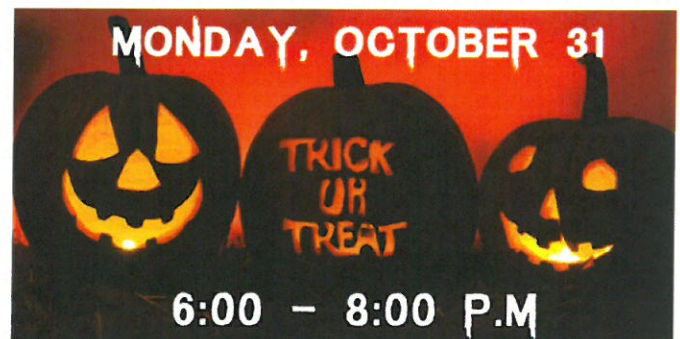
