Public Comment:

Lisa Riley said she is the current and delinquent Tax Collector. It was just brought to her attention that they are voting on a new delinquent tax collector without her input or feedback. She asked the board to look at all the information before they vote. She said she is not sure how much the board knows about the other person. She said she sent an e-mail to the commissioners and asked that they table this vote until she can meet with them to discuss this, as she was not aware what was going on.

Mr. Castello said it was not true. He said he talked to her last month and told her they need a more aggressive course of delinquent collections and that they want three complaints filed a month. They started the program on August 14, 2013 when they first told her they wanted a more aggressive program. They were willing to work with her and she did not file complaints until February or March of 2014. In June he told her again he wanted complaints filed. Nothing was filed. He said they do not want letters sent; they want complaints filed. They have been after her since 2014 to put this program in place and she didn't do it.

Mrs. Riley said for the first three years they were not collecting interest. They had to change the system and there was legwork involved.

Mr. Castello said there were two meetings with the board.

Mrs. Riley said she is just asking for a fair shot.

Mr. Castello said 1 1/2 years is a fair shot.

Mrs. Riley said she cares about the tax payers, she treats them with respect and she is working with them. She said she is an honest person and does honest work.

Mr. Castello said she only reacts when they say they are going to do something.

Mr. Wells said she told them she was going to work on it in July and August. He asked if the board tables this and meets with her, will she be ready to do that.

Mrs. Riley said yes. She said there is research involved in sending a magistrate letter.

Mr. Wells asked what she does with foreclosures.

Mrs. Riley said if they go into bankruptcy they are still responsible for their taxes.

Mr. Vogel said that is a complicated process.

Mrs. Riley said she liens the property every year and charges interest.

Mr. Wells said they need to sit down with her and they can vote on this next month. 1-26-2016 rm

### Public Comments on Items Not Listed on Agenda

Andrea Snyder of 586 Hope Street said she is concerned about the park they are planning. She said Scott Township has nine parks within a 4 mile radius.

Mr. Giudici said the park is off. It is not going to be built.

Ms. Snyder asked why the surveyor's stakes are there.

Mr. Giudici said the dirt from the park is being moved there. He said it is not a private drive – it is owned by the township.

Mr. Wells said the lot at the end of the street is owned by the township and they also own the old section of the road.

Ms. Snyder said it was never maintained by the township.

Mr. Lubin said the public works employees have been instructed when it is bad to clear it.

Ms. Snyder said it has not been done since she moved there in 1983.

Mr. Giudici asked why there is a "private drive" sign there.

Mr. Lubin said it has always been there.

Ms. Ciccone said her father has maintained that road by himself for the over sixty years he has lived there.

Ken Sturbeon of 574 Hope Street asked if it will be paved since it is a township road. He said he is always putting gravel there to try to fill pot holes.

Mr. Wells said that might be something they should look into.

Mr. Giudici said to put it on the agenda.

Mr. Sturbeon asked if they can take down the "private drive" sign.

Mr. Calabria said they should wait until they look into it.

Mr. Wells said it is only about 100 ft. of road.

Beth Tomasovich of 1707 Berkwood Drive said she received the offer from the township. If she accepts the proposal how long does she have to find another place?

Mr. Giudici said as long as she wants.

Mr. Calabria asked if she is considering the offer.

Ms. Tomasovich said if they are not going to fix it.

Mr. Giudici said it is a \$1,000,000 fix.

Mr. Wells said they might be able to block up the garage instead of moving.

Mr. Calabria asked how much property she has on the sides of the house.

Ms. Tomasovich said not much. That is where the sewer lines are.

Mr. Castello said they want to know her decision in thirty days, but she would not have to move.

Lynn Galluze (558 Robin Drive), Vince Mazza (550 Robin Drive) and Matt Palmieri (540 Robin Drive) approached the podium.

Mr. Mazza asked the board's intentions for the property. He said if it sold, it all backs up to their property.

Mr. Giudici said they might sell it or hold on to it for green space.

Mr. Palmieri said he saw a retention pond on the drawing.

Mr. Lennon said that was part of the park and it is going away.

Ms. Gullaze asked about necessary permitting for the property and for the dirt being moved there.

Mr. Lennon assured her that all appropriate permits were obtained.

Ms. Galluze asked how she could obtain copies.

Mr. Vogel said she can download the Right to Know form and submit it.

Mr. Lennon said the grading is in compliance with the permit.

Ms. Gullaza asked if Mr. Lennon considers the ravine a waterway.

Mr. Lennon said he does not consider it; it is up to the state.

Mr. Wells said there is no longer water flowing on Hope Hollow Road. He asked how O'Hommel harnessed the water.

Mr. Lennon said that has nothing to do with this project. He said he is a Professional Engineer with forty years experience and the township engineer. He said the grading permit is exempted by the township's own ordinance and they are not going into the steep slope.

Mr. Wells asked if they did a geo technical study. He said if the township wants a soil study it can be done. They can spend the money to analyze soil but he does not think they will find anything.

Ms. Galluze said according to the stormwater management ordinance any property within 200 feet must be notified.

Mr. Lennon said he is not aware of that, but he will look into it.

Mr. Wells suggested they contact Mr. Cargioni to see if he wants the dirt and this problem would go away.

Mr. Lennon said he is not going to speak for the contractor. His contract is to move the dirt to Hope Street. He said he has been doing this for a long time and he knows what permits they need. If they want a change, they will have to renegotiate with the contractor. He said they are speculating here. The contractor will want more money if there is a change in scope of the work.

Ms. Galluze said the board was willing to spend a lot of money on something that is not going to happen.

Mr. Mazza asked about the logs on the property.

Mr. Wells asked if they are not violating any part of the steep slope ordinance.

Mr. Lennon said they are exempt from it.

Mr. Calabria said there is no grading and no geo technical report has been done.

Ms. Galuzzi said it is zoned R-1 so they can only build a single family dwelling.

Mr. Giudici said he responded to Mr. Calabria's e-mail. They have a engineer and he relies on him to have everything in order.

Pat Martin of Center Street said years ago they moved dirt to her street and she was told by the manager at that time that anytime dirt is moved from one place to another it has to be tested. She said this was at the pool and could contain chlorine from the pool. She asked where the money will go if this project is cancelled.

Mr. Castello said some is from the bond issue and will go back to the bond issue. There is \$326,608 that must go to a like project because it is bond money. They would need a project that has the same life.

Mr. Wells said he is concerned about the steep slope. There are other areas of Scott Township with a steep slope and if they violate their own steep slope ordinance, anybody can come in and say they want to do the same.

Mr. Vogel said that would not fly legally. Nobody can come in and say the township violated the steep slope, so now he can.

Barbara Solenburger of Newburn Drive Mt. Lebanon said she attended the Mt. Lebanon meeting and White Buffalo will be baiting the deer for three weeks then they will be shooting of public property from 6:00-11:00 p.m. She said there will be poaching going on that will impact Scott Township.
